

# APPENDIX A

## BYLAW NO. 1839

BEING A BYLAW OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF BONNYVILLE NO. 87, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF GRANTING A LICENSE OR PERMIT FOR THE TEMPORARY OCCUPATION OR USE OF A ROAD ALLOWANCE.

**WHEREAS**, Section 13(1)(o) of the Traffic Safety Act, Chapter T-6, RSA 2000, as amended, grants the authority to a Council to pass a bylaw granting a license or a permit for the temporary occupation or use of a road allowance when it is not required for public use, if such license or permit is terminable on 30 days' notice;

**AND WHEREAS**, the land hereafter described is no longer required for public travel;

**AND WHEREAS**, application has been made to the Council for the temporary use and occupation of the said lands;

**AND WHEREAS**, notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been published in a newspaper circulating in the municipality advising of the date for a Public Hearing;

**AND WHEREAS**, persons claiming to be affected by the proposed bylaw and any other person wishing to make representations were afforded an opportunity to be heard by Council through Public Hearing at a public meeting of Council prior to the final passing thereof;

**NOW THEREFORE**, Council of the Municipal District of Bonnyville No. 87, duly assembled in the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. That Council of the Municipal District of Bonnyville No. 87 does hereby grant a license for the temporary occupation or use of the following roadway:
  - 1.1. All that portion of Government Road Allowance east of NE 32-61-1-W4M commencing approximately 330 meters south of Township Road 620, reserving unto His Majesty all Mines and Minerals.
2. That the license be for a term not exceeding 3 years and that it may be terminated on 30 days' notice in writing.
3. That no erection of any building, structure or other permanent improvement except for a fence be permitted.
4. That the license be issued subject to rights of access granted by other provincial and municipal legislation or regulations.
5. That such license be issued to Owen Stonehocker of PO Box 284, Cherry Grove, Alberta, T0A 0T0.
6. That this license be granted as of the date the associated Roadway License Agreement is made effective, until the termination or withdrawal of the associated Roadway License Agreement.
7. That this Bylaw shall come into force and have effect from and after the date of third and final reading thereof.

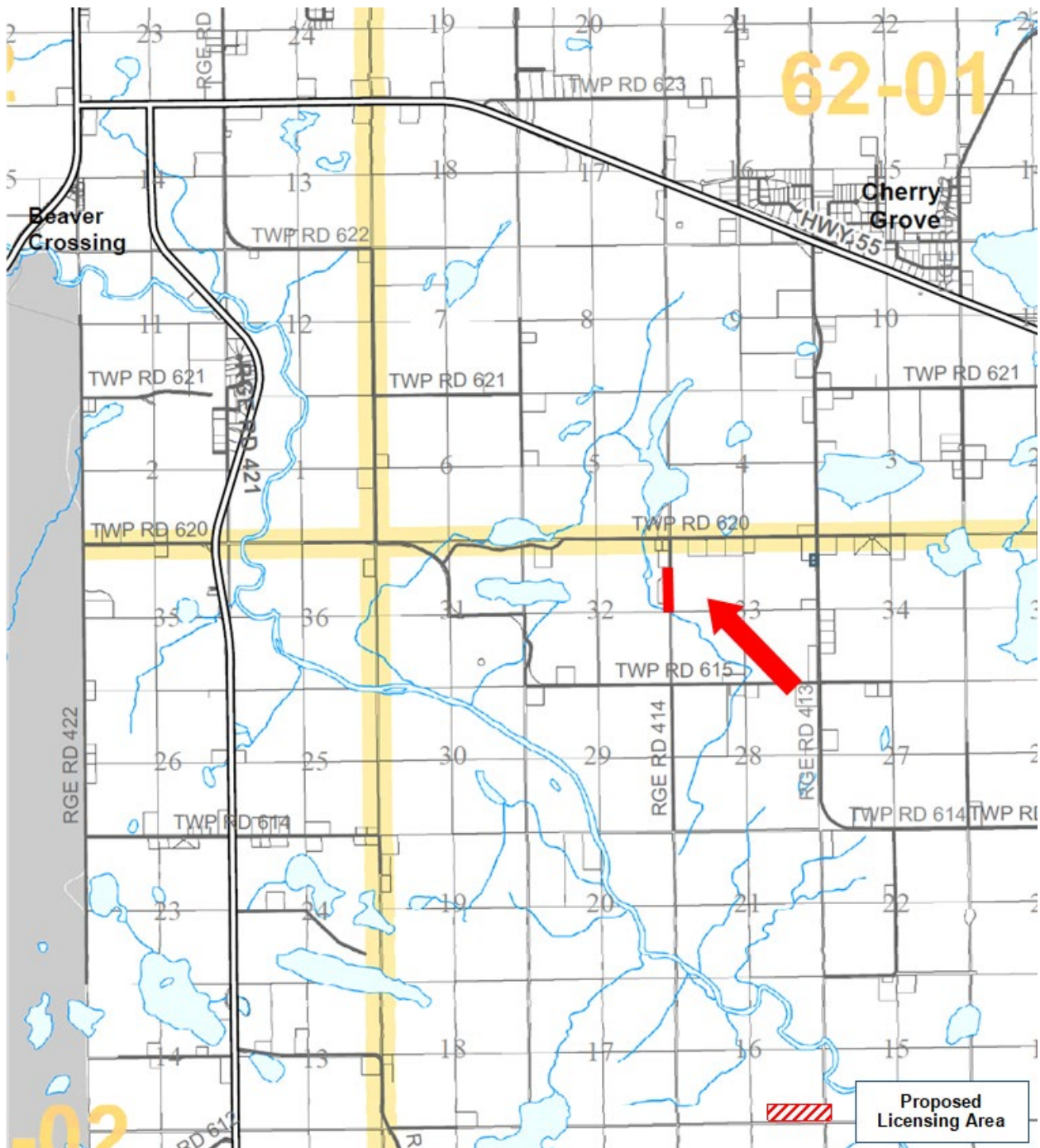
