Title: Vehicle Purchase – Hydrovac Truck

PROPOSAL & BACKGROUND

Infrastructure Services is needing to replace Unit 7910/7910-2 (2006 Freightliner and hydrovac/flusher). This unit was originally scheduled to be replaced in 2016, however, Infrastructure Services attempted to extend the service life of the unit for a few more years to obtain maximum value of the equipment. As the service life of this unit has expired, Infrastructure Services budgeted for, and Council approved, a replacement in the 2023 Capital Budget.

DISCUSSION ON BENEFITS, DISADVANTAGES & OPTIONS

Administration solicited a bid for the replacement unit through Canoe Procurement Group of Canada (RMA), and received a quote for a unit with the specifications requested. (APPENDIX A)

As Canoe Procurement Group of Canada already tendered pricing from multiple vendors for this unit, the M.D. was able to meet all legislative procurement requirements and obtain the best pricing by going through a single source.

The price of the new unit was below the budgeted amount in the approved M.D. 2023 Capital Budget.

Administration will return to Council with a recommendation for the disposal of Unit 7910/7910-2 at a later date.
