Title:	Bylaw No. 1844 2023 Tax Rate Bylaw	

PROPOSAL & BACKGROUND

Administration hereby presents the 2023 Tax Rate Bylaw. Section 353 of the Municipal Government Act (MGA) requires municipal councils to annually pass a bylaw to raise revenues to be used towards the payment of municipal expenditures and transfers defined in the budget and the requisitions. The bylaw shall meet the requirements of Order in Council 121/2021 Annexing Land from Improvement District No. 349 to The Municipal District of Bonnyville No. 87 and Dissolving Improvement District No. 349, and MGA Section 358.1 Maximum Tax Ratio. Council has estimated \$109,903,727 to be generated from municipal taxes to fund expenditures for 2023.
