BYLAW NO. 1746

BEING A BYLAW OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF BONNYVILLE NO. 87, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO IMPOSE PENALTIES ON UNPAID TAXES.

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26.1, R.S.A. 2000, authority is granted to municipalities to impose penalties by bylaw on unpaid taxes; and

WHEREAS Council of the Municipal District of Bonnyville No. 87 deems it expedient and necessary to have such a bylaw in effect.

NOW THEREFORE Council of the Municipal District of Bonnyville No. 87, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. a) THAT a penalty of twelve (12%) percent be applied to all current taxes remaining unpaid after the fifteenth day of October or thirty (30) days after the tax notice is sent, whichever date is later, in any year.

b) THAT the penalty shall be added on the sixteenth day of October or thirty one (31) days after a tax notice has been sent, whichever date is later.

c) THAT the said penalty, when applied, shall form part of the current unpaid taxes.
2. a) THAT any taxes remaining unpaid after the thirty first day of December of the year for which they are levied, there shall be added thereto by way of penalty, an amount of ten (10%) percent in the next succeeding year so long as the taxes remain unpaid.


b) THAT the said penalty shall be applied to the unpaid taxes as at the first day of March of the succeeding year and shall be added thereto on that day.

c) THAT the said penalty, when applied, shall form part of the unpaid taxes.
3. THAT nothing in this bylaw shall be construed to extend the time for payment of taxes nor in any way to impair the right of distress or any other remedy provided by the Municipal Government Act for the collection of taxes.
4. THAT this bylaw repeals Bylaw No. 1628.
5. THAT this bylaw take effect on the final passing thereof.
