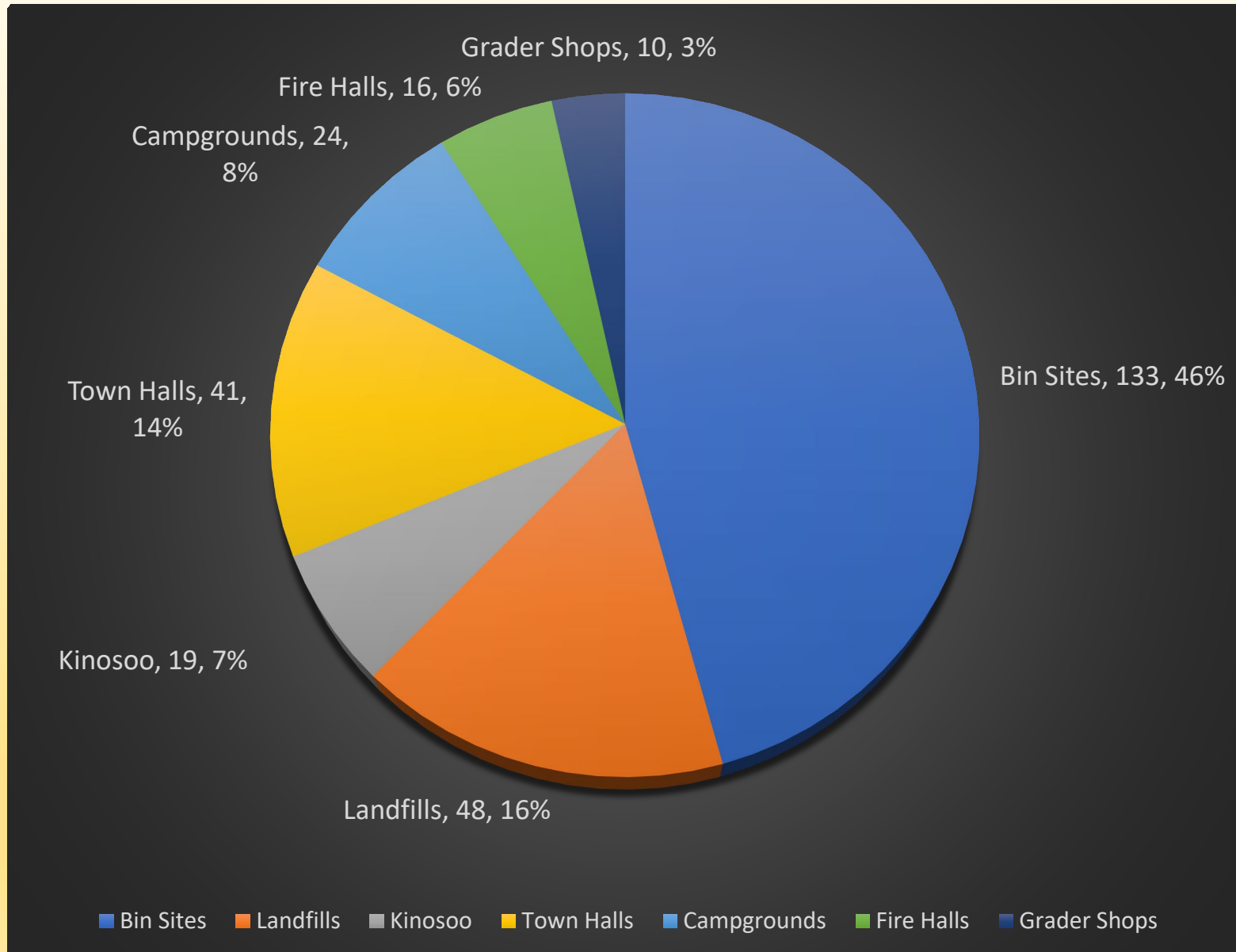

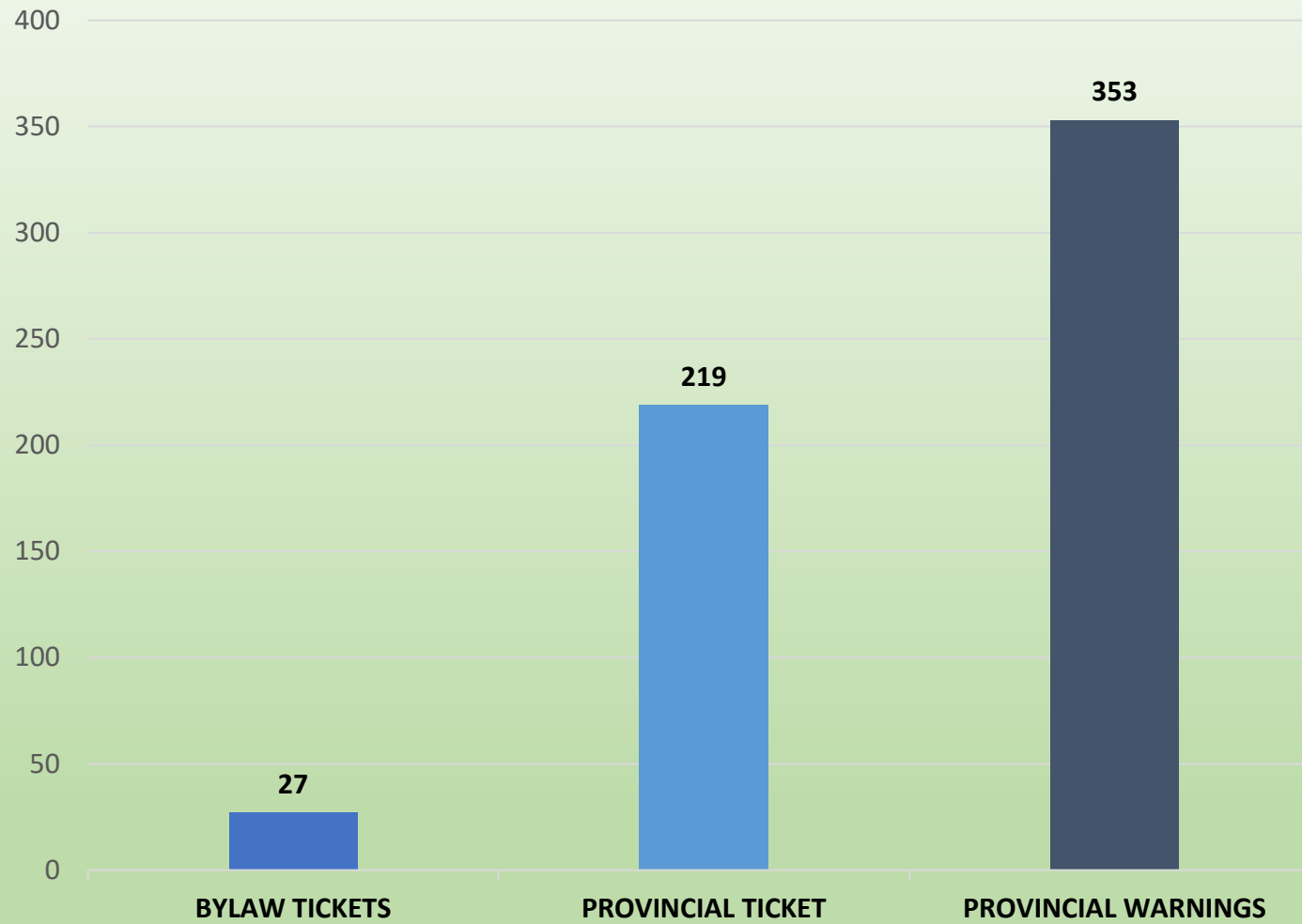
Many of our Peace Officers are trained to inspect commercial vehicles for safety violations
