
BIGS is the result of the 2020 Regional Economic Development Plan Technical Report and 2022-2027 M.D. Council Strategic Plan.

The Strategic Plan identifies building a viable and diversified regional economy as one of the first goals, with the objective of developing an economic development strategy inclusive of business and industry attraction, retention, and expansion while maintaining the M.D.'s rural influences.

The BIGS document outlines the economic future of the M.D, including investment readiness, economic diversification, and brand development.

BIGS includes the following tactics: a free online Business Registry program, Commercial and Industrial property listings, Community Profile, the identification of shovel-ready projects, Business Visit program, Economic Development Branding, Airport Enhancements, and a Champion Ambassador Program. These tactics are recognized as the foundation of municipal-lead business and industrial growth.
