Title:	Bylaw No. 1854 Amending Waste and Resource Recovery Management Bylaw

PROPOSAL & BACKGROUND

At the April 18th Committee of the Whole Meeting, Administration presented a report on the waste services supplied to Community Halls in the M.D. of Bonnyville. Following the report, Administration recommended to the Committee to direct Administration to draft an amendment to Bylaw No. 1627 Waste and Resource Recovery Management stating that upon written request, the Municipal District of Bonnyville would supply a waste disposal receptacle to any of the Community Halls. The first reading of this Bylaw No. 1854 to amend the Waste and Resource Recovery Management Bylaw was passed at the July 11th Regular Meeting of Council.

DISCUSSION ON BENEFITS, DISADVANTAGES & OPTIONS

By making the amendment to this bylaw, Community Halls located in the Municipal District of Bonnyville will be permitted to submit a written request for the supply of a waste disposal receptacle. This service will be of benefit to all Community Halls by assisting them to minimize their operating expenses.
