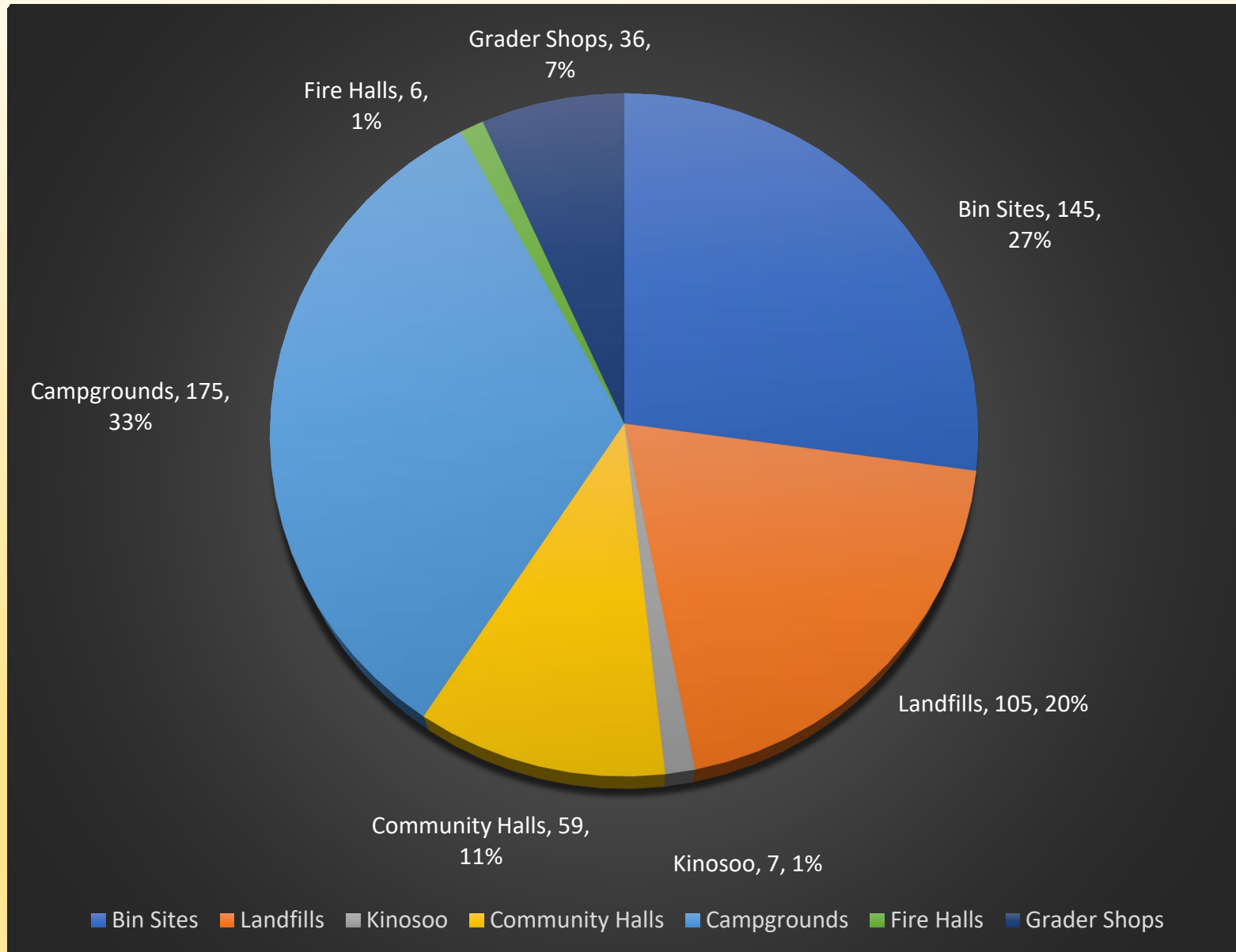

- In the Second quarter of 2023, we delivered 293.5 hours of patrol services to our industry partners on a fee for service basis.



Commercial Vehicles

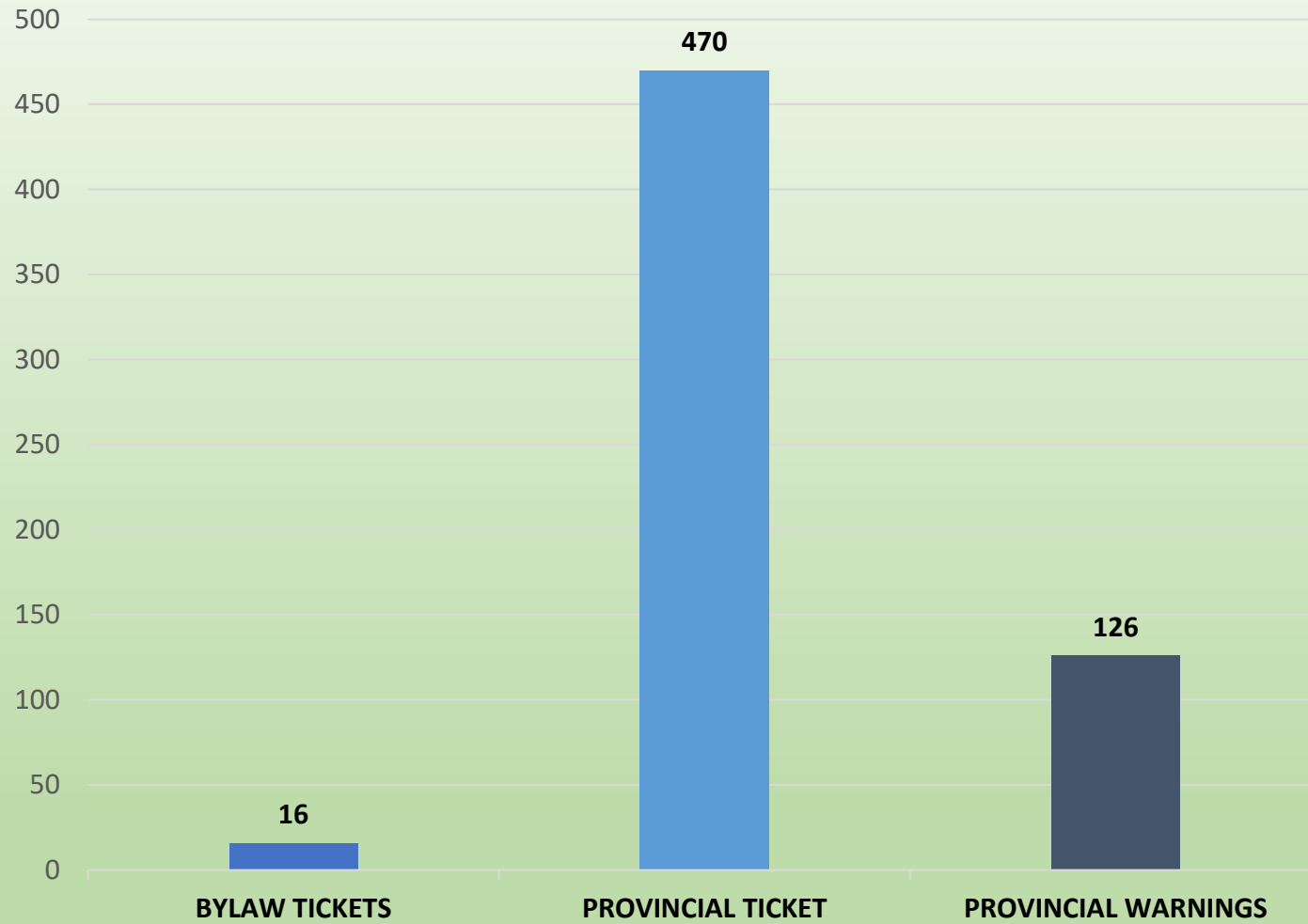


Many of our Peace Officers are trained to inspect commercial vehicles for safety violations

During this quarter of **2023**, MD Peace Officers conducted **85** commercial vehicle inspections, resulting in **25** vehicles out of service.

Overweight vehicles damaging MD roads are a priority for Public Safety. This quarter **16** violators were apprehended.

- During this quarter of 2023 we investigated 2 trespassing incidents within the MD.

The School Resource Officer Program delivered 298 presentations to over **5,066** students during the second quarter of 2023.
