Statement

The confinement of exotic animals for the purpose of game farming (such as buffalo, deer and elk) within the Municipal District of Bonnyville (M.D.) requires specialized fencing. This fencing is very costly in comparison with the standard barbed wire fence used to contain domestic livestock. No rates for specialized fencing over the regular domestic livestock fencing rate has been established.

Purpose

To prevent additional costs, over and above standard fencing rates for domestic livestock fences, in conjunction with road construction.

Policy

(1) A development permit shall be required for the construction of specialized fencing adjacent to a municipal road right-of-way other than the standard three or four barbed wire fence. The specialized fencing shall be constructed a minimum distance of 50 feet (15.24 metres) from the centre line of the municipal right-of-way.
