As you are aware, during the week of NDTR, the **Lakeland Society for Truth and Reconciliation** will be hosting a series of activities in commemoration of NDTR. This year we are adding two new activities to our week of commemoration:

- 1. <u>September 21, 2023 Blanket Workshop with Dr. Patricia Makokis.</u> This event will help connect Indigenous and non-Indigenous individuals by creating a safe place for conversation, sharing, and learning about what it means to build allies within our community.
- 2. <u>September 25, 2023 Tour of the Former Blue Quills Residential School.</u> This tour will be guided by a Blue Quills Residential School Survivor and is focused on visualizing what the Residential School Experience meant for our local Indigenous community members.

NDTR Commemorative activities were so well received last year. We are excited to offer this opportunity to the community once again.
