TRAIL ETIQUETTE

- 1 Skiers coming downhill have the right-of-way.
- 2 Walk or snowshoe to the side of the ski tracks, not on top.
- **3** Keep the trails clean. Pack out what you pack in.

4 Yield to faster skiers

- 5 Do not stop in the tracks or in areas poorly visible to oncoming skiers. Move off the track quickly if you fall or need to rest.
- Show courtesy to others who use the trails – walkers, bikers, skiers, and snowshoers.
