2. Introductions

Caltex Trilogy

- We are a privately owned oil and gas company that is relatively new to the M.D. area.

3. Activity

Canadian Natural Resources Limited (CNRL)

- In the thermal field things are the same as last year. You will not see any increase in traffic.

4. Roads

4.1 Road Use Agreement

- Al – We implemented no bans this year, it seems to have gone well for all industry partners. Everyone was content and the M.D. did not see any major issues.
- Bryan – It has been easy dealing with our industry partners, there is great communication, and it has become a great working relationship.
- Monty – If you are aware of someone damaging roads, please let us know. This helps us save our road, especially if you are shut down, we don't want you blamed for road issues that are not your fault.
- Councillor Slipchuk – Do your operators contact the M.D. when they notice a concern? Yes, even contractors call the M.D. when they notice road issues. Councillor Slipchuk would like to be informed when concerns come in. Al and Bryan suggest they will discuss how to inform the Councillor.

4.2 Dust Control

- Bryan – When we receive a concern, we can contact industry immediately and to be dealt with. Monty stated that there are some roads that are now being used as truck routes, he suggests that we need to figure out a way to maintain.
- Reeve Kalinski – I have been hearing that Council would like to MG30 entire roads. CNRL Foreman stated that Industry partners contact every resident on the road when applying the initial MG30 application, if someone disagrees then industry will not apply in front of their house. Al suggests that if you get pushback contact the M.D. to see if we can assist with the issue.
- Councillor Slipchuk asked if we were investigating other products. Bryan informed him that we had a presentation a couple of weeks ago, but we need to investigate the product further.

5. Airport

- Al
 - We are moving ahead with the project, if anyone wants to donate it is not too late.
 - The airport has become busy, and we are seeing lots of traffic. We had approx. 1500 flights last year and even more this year.
 - Al suggests that if industry would like to reach out to West Jet to see interest it would be ok.

6. Round Table

- Theft and Vandalism
 - o Industry partners have been experiencing an extreme amount of theft and vandalism on sites.
 - o The M.D. has been meeting with multiple Ministers, MPs, and the MLA's to discuss the ongoing situation in our area. Al suggested that oil field companies should contact the Minister's about the issues.
- CNRL: La Corey Resource Road Agreement will come due in 2026, we would like to start the discussions in 2025. We appreciate the Peace Officers that attend the area as the highway is extremely busy.
- Reeve Kalinski: Merry Christmas and have a safe and prosperous New Year.
- Bryan: Communication between industry and the M.D. is extremely important and it is also important to have communication between industry partners as well.
- Al: M.D. of Bonnyville will be hosting an RMA District 5 Meeting on Friday, January 26, 2024. If anyone is interested in sponsoring the lunch and having a speaking opportunity, please contact Robin. It may be a great opportunity to speak with elected officials.
- Councillor Slipchuk: If you could please communicate to your contractors to reduce the use of jake brakes within a mile and a half from La Corey.
