Re: Funding Request Proposal – Hearts for Healthcare 2024 Gala

At Hearts for Healthcare, we strive to improve healthcare in Cold Lake with the unwavering help of our community. Our aim is to ensure that everyone has access to proper care from preventative medicine to emergency services. Our main initiatives include: the purchase of medical equipment, fostering facility upgrades, supporting our healthcare professionals and the public through awareness and advocacy and medical professional recruitment and retention.

The Hearts for Healthcare Gala is our primary fundraiser, and this year it is being held on May 4, 2024 at the Cold Lake Energy Centre. The recruitment and retention of Medical Professionals to our area remains at the forefront of our efforts and a primary concern heard from our community members and stakeholders. We have worked diligently to develop a program that builds and nurtures these efforts in response to the immense need to bring physicians into our community. We have built a strong community partnership with key stakeholders, like yourselves, and feel that our Recruitment and Retention Program will continue to have great success in ensuring that everyone in our community can access a family physician, reduce emergency room wait times and relieve the pressure on our current team of healthcare professionals.

Our request to you is to maintain this collaborative community partnership that continues to have a direct impact on creating safe and healthy environments where your employees work, live and play. We are asking for your consideration of commitment to the following:

- 1. Superior Level Support for the purchase of equipment from Our Healthcare Wishlist. This list includes items requested from the many healthcare facilities/departments that we support including, Cold Lake Healthcare Centre, Cold Lake Community Health Services (Allied Health, Public Health, Long Term Care, Home Care, Mental Health & Addictions), Cold Lake Primary Care Network including the Elizabeth Metis Settlement Outreach Clinic and Cold Lake First Nations Health Centre. Superior Level Sponsorship includes 2 tables of 8 at the event.
- 2. In-Kind contribution of the following MD related packages for our Silent Auction:

- Kinosoo Ridge Ski Resort Package: Family of 5 Pass with gift card for The Ridge Restaurant
- b. MD Campground Package: full service weekend camping at one of the MD Campgrounds and bundle of firewood
- 3. Attendance to the Hearts for Healthcare Gala on Saturday, May 4, 2024. (2 Tables of 8)


Your collaboration and support of these programs will have a substantial and direct benefit to our Community.

Serviceable Area:

- *Cold Lake's population is approximately 17,000 people
- *The Cold Lake Healthcare Centre services a surrounding area of more than 40,000 people that utilizes our hospital programs and services
- *The catchment area that utilizes our healthcare facilities includes: Cold Lake, 4 Wing Cold Lake, Bonnyville, St Paul, Elk Point, communities into Saskatchewan, also our 12 surrounding indigenous communities including: Cold Lake First Nations, Elizabeth Metis Settlement.

Partnership Successes:

- *5 new physicians joined our team last year partly due to community stakeholder investments in our Attraction and Retention Programs and the purchase of equipment that aids in these professionals having the necessary tools to do their jobs safely and effectively.
- *Your contribution in 2023 Gala helped us purchase specialty equipment for the Endoscopy Program at the Cold Lake Healthcare Centre that provided our surgical team with the necessary tools to allow patients to receive diagnostic and screening services close to home. It resulted in lower wait times for surgeries by decreasing turnover time between cases and allowing more surgeries per day, decreased wait times and reduced stress on the system, promoted continuity of care when the patient can receive their assessment, treatment and recovery at home. The event raised \$340,000
- *Your contribution directly resulted in the purchase of a P500 Therapy Surface for our residents in Long Term Care. This equipment helps patients who are unable to leave their bed or have wounds or skin break down. This surface helps address and prevent shearing, friction and pressure to skin surfaces, thus preventing wounds and infection.
- *Your support in 2021 into the Cold Lake Primary Care Network helped purchase an Infusion Pump for the new Infusion Clinic established in September 2022. This essential addition decreased wait times for patients receiving iron infusions and decreased stress on our Emergency Room.



The Cold Lake PCN has been able to increase the amount of Iron Infusion clinics from 1-2 days per week to 3-4 days per week.

And from 5 Iron Infusions per day to 9-16 Iron Infusions per day.

*Your support of the 2022 and 2023 Sparkle in the Park helped us in showing our appreciation to our community, spreading kindness and improving mental health awareness. This year the event saw 3200 vehicles go through your campground in 6 days, raised \$30,000 for mental health initiatives and had over 55+ businesses, organizations, schools, sport groups and individuals signed up to add their sparkle to the event

Community Struggles:

- *accessibility and inclusivity are two major factors that our Indigenous communities face, investments in programs such as CLFNS Palliative Care and Elizabeth Metis Settlement Outreach Clinic ensure that members can easily access personalized and compassionate care, that services offered are culturally sensitive and respect the values and traditions community members. These pieces of equipment will significantly improve the quality of life for community members.
- *recurring overnight ER closures due to staff shortages. Attraction and retention efforts not only improve the patient experience and well-being but the mental and physical health and well-being of staff
- *patients sometimes need to travel great distances for services; losing wages, social support and time. Programs like the CLPCN Infusion Clinic allow these patients to access a safe and comfortable space to receive their treatments close to home.

We hope that you will consider helping us in our continued efforts in nurturing and encouraging growth within our current healthcare team by providing them with the appropriate resources, equipment and support staff.
