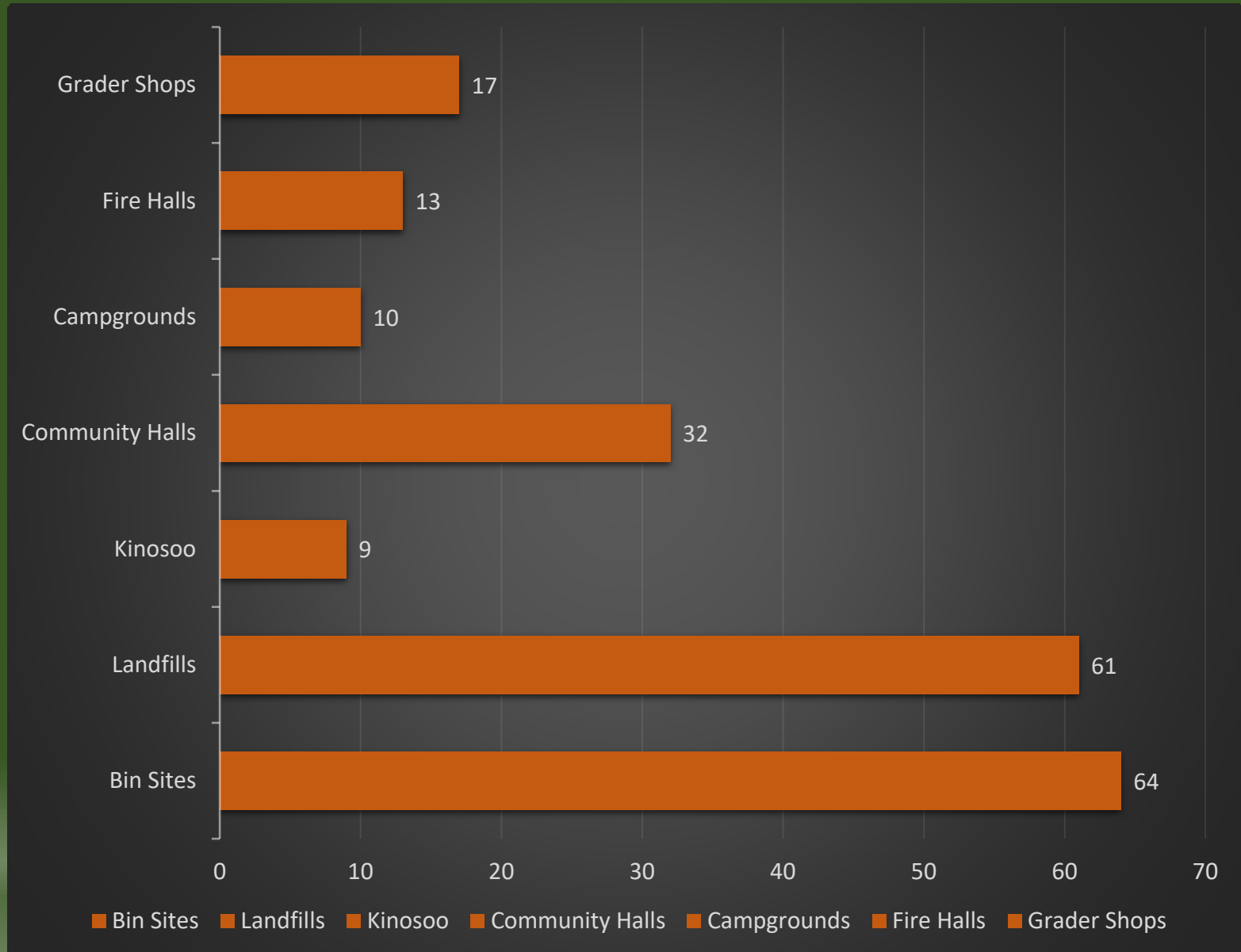

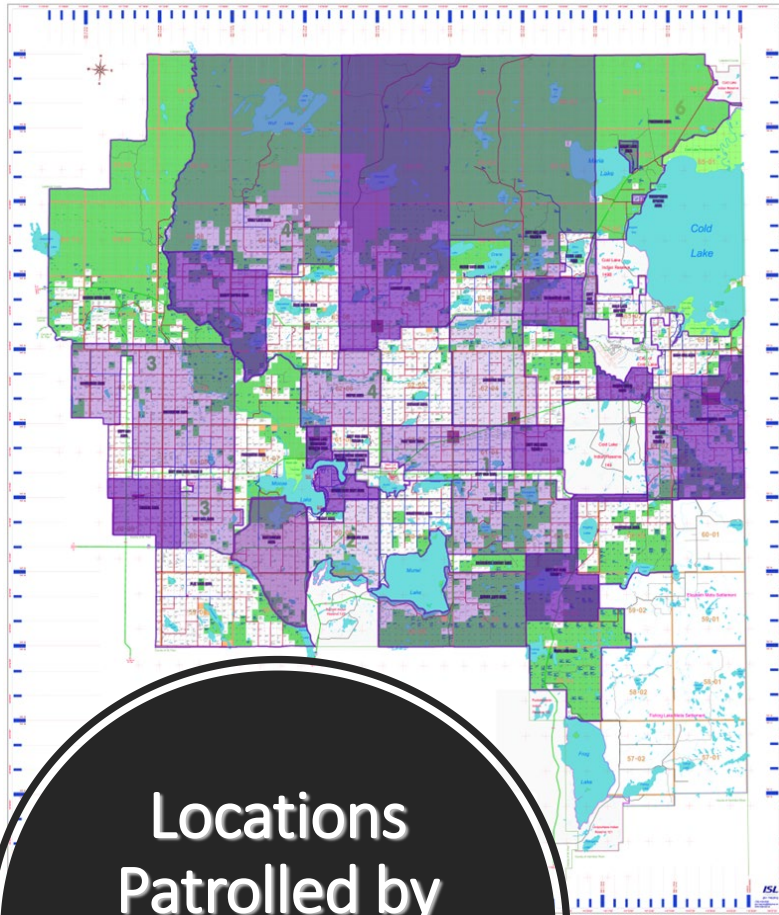
**Overweight vehicles damaging MD roads are a priority for Public Safety. This quarter 2 violators were given 5 warnings and 1 ticket.**
