Dear Community Leaders,

I hope this message finds you well.

I am writing to share an important update from the Office of the Minister of Immigration and Multiculturalism. As announced by Honourable Muhammad Yaseen, the Alberta Opportunity Stream under the Alberta Advantage Immigration Program (AAIP) will resume effective June 11, 2024.

The AAIP plays a critical role in addressing key labour gaps across Alberta by attracting and recruiting international talent, thereby strengthening our local and provincial economies. Despite the high demand for immigration to Alberta, our province has received an allocation to nominate 9,750 provincial nominees for 2024, consistent with the previous year's allocation.

To manage this limited number of nominations effectively, AAIP will now invite a targeted number of qualified applications each month. This new approach aims to provide prospective nominees with multiple opportunities to apply throughout the year, ensuring a balanced and efficient process.
