The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) has opened a 30-day public comment period to obtain feedback on draft Specified Enactment Direction (SED) Pipeline Conservation and Reclamation Approvals Under the Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act: Requirements and Guidance for Applications and Postconstruction Reclamation Assessment Reports.

The draft SED provides direction for:

- Pipeline proponents when preparing pipeline applications under the Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act (EPEA).
- Pipeline EPEA approval holders when conducting a Post-Construction Reclamation
   Assessment (PCRA). A PCRA is a standard condition of a pipeline EPEA approval to 1) verify
   the completion of the reclamation terms and conditions of the EPEA approval, and 2) to
   document that the post-construction project site is on a trajectory to equivalent land
   capability.
