**Title:** Amendment to Bylaw No. 1796 Master Speed Rate

### **PROPOSAL & BACKGROUND**

On July 25<sup>th</sup>, 2023, the M.D. contracted a bridge inspector to conduct an inspection on a single-lane bridge found at Range Road 485A and the Beaver River (Truman Bridge). The inspector recommended that a speed reduction be implemented on the bridge to 30 km/h as this would enhance public safety and reduce the structural impact on the bridge. Infrastructure Services believes this is a best practice and requests that all single-lane bridges within the M.D. be slowed and signed to accommodate a 30 km/h travel speed. All single-lane bridges within the M.D. are currently signposted to either 60 km/h or 80 km/h.

#### **DISCUSSION ON BENEFITS, DISADVANTAGES & OPTIONS**

The 4 single-lane bridges in question are:

- BF72355 Range Road 4100 vs. Beaver River "Aylesworth Bridge"
- BF72515 Range Road 485A vs. Beaver River "Truman Bridge"
- 3. BF7431 Township Road 624 vs. Beaver River "Tillers Bridge"
- 4. BF9595 Range Road 452A vs. Beaver River "Lessard Bridge"

While the inspection only mentioned the Truman Bridge, Administration has found that a speed reduction to 30 km/h on single-lane bridges is widespread throughout the province, and with 3 of our 4 bridges unpaved, a speed reduction may be appropriate for all of them. Additionally, changing all of them at once would maintain uniformity of speeds throughout the M.D. while reducing wear and tear on these 4 bridges.
