Statement

The Municipal District of Bonnyville (M.D.) is committed to protecting and maintaining the health, safety, and welfare of employees, visitors/volunteers, and contractors at its worksites, addressing physical, psychological and social well-being.

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to establish management's commitment and leadership as the essential foundation for a successful occupational health and safety management system.

Definitions

For the purposes of this policy:

- (1) "Chief Administrative Officer" (CAO) means the Chief Administrative Officer of the Municipal District of Bonnyville appointed by Council, or their authorized delegate;
- (2) "Council" means the duly elected Council of the M.D.;
- (3) "Management" means the CAO, General Managers, Managers, and their authorized delegates;
- (4) "Supervisor" means any individual employed the M.D. whose job responsibilities include supervision of other employees (includes Managers, Foreman, Officers, etc.).

Policy

- (1) All work performed for the M.D. must meet the requirements identified in the *Alberta Occupational Health and Safety Act, Regulation, and Code* and must comply with the M.D. Occupational Health and Safety Management System. As a core value, occupational health and safety will be integrated into all M.D. work activities.
- (2) Council, management, employees, visitors/volunteers, and contractors are all responsible and accountable for the municipality's health and safety performance and are expected to comply with applicable provincial and municipal legislation including the M.D.'s Occupational Health and Safety Management System.
