To the MD of Bonnyville Council:

Over the past 27 years, the support from the MD of Bonnyville has been a valuable community partnership as we carry out our mission and vision to reach our goals of providing leading-edge programs and services, research, education, and to purchase state-of-the-art equipment for our hospital. After incredible community response from our 2024 Gala, our Foundation has been assured that we are surrounded by a health-minded community that shares our goals of transforming good health to great healthcare, right here at home.

We would be honoured if the MD of Bonnyville would consider the following commitment of support for the Bonnyville Health Foundation in 2025:

FUTURE PLANNING

Please note that on Wednesday, June 12, 2024, the Bonnyville Health Foundation Board of Directors motioned to accept the project presented by the Bonnyville Health Centre, to fund the addition of a CT Scanner on site. The proposed model, GE Healthcare Revolution Apex Elite CT Scanner has a quoted cost of 1.7 million dollars. The Foundation has also agreed to fundraise an addition 1.4 million dollars to cushion the start up wages for CT technicians and the renovations required to accommodate the unit.

This forecasted 5-year project will remain in the quiet phase as we seek grant funding to start up the project. It is common fundraising practice to acquire 80% of a project this size prior to seeking public donor dollars. As a valued funding partner, the Foundation intends to keep the MD of Bonnyville Council up to date on the progress of this campaign, in the event that Council will consider an isolated investment into this project when the time comes.



We are truly blessed to live in such a generous community that continues, even throughout challenging times, to support the legacy of healing the body, enriching the mind, and nurturing the soul in our Lakeland community. Thank you for being a part of that!
