PROPOSAL

The Executive Director of North East Muni-Corr Ltd. has requested amendments to the Municipal District of Bonnyville No. 87's Muni-Corr bylaw. These changes would align the M.D. with other Muni-Corr partner communities who have already implemented the changes.

DISCUSSION

The Director of Protective Services has reviewed the requested amendments and provided feedback to the Executive Director expressing concerns with some of the wording used in the amended bylaw. The Executive Director has accepted these suggestions and agreed to revisit the bylaw within two years as they have a review planned during that time. Despite these minor gaps, the Executive Director has requested that the amended bylaw be approved by Council to align the M.D. with our other partner communities. Any gaps in wording are considered minor, and given the imminent review by North East Muni-Corr Ltd, Administration does not object to this amended bylaw being recommended by the Committee as-is.
