

This year again, the outdoor rinks opened later than usual because of the warmer weather. The M.D. balances the safety of the public and the quality of the ice with public demand.

It is noted that the temperature for flooding rinks should be consistently between -7 C and -20 C to successfully maintain the ice's integrity. Our Parks staff regularly groom and maintain 13 km of trail in the Muriel Lake M.D. Park throughout the winter. November 28, 2024 - the crew was out on the trails packing the recent snow however, there were still sticks and leaves coming to the surface. The crew updates the trails being groomed on the Nordic Pulse app for all to check for updates.
