APPENDIX C BYLAW NO. 1212

BEING A BYLAW OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF BONNYVILLE NO. 87, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO ESTABLISH THE ASSESSOR POSITION AS A DESIGNATED OFFICER

WHEREAS the Council deems it desirable to provide for qualified Assessors to exercise property assessment powers, duties and functions on behalf of the Municipal District of Bonnyville No. 87; and

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act and Regulations, as amended from time to time, require Council to establish a Designated Officer for this purpose and detail the Qualifications of Assessors;

NOW THEREFORE the Council enacts the following:

- 1. That the Designated Officer shall be qualified Assessor.
- 2. That the Municipal Manager, in accordance with Bylaw 1120, shall appoint one or more qualified Assessors as he considers necessary to serve as Designated Officers.
- 3. That the duties, responsibilities and authority of the Assessor Position are as set out in the Municipal Government Act and related Regulations, as amended from time to time.
- 4. This bylaw shall take effect on the day of final passing thereof.
