Title: Bylaw No. 1887 Roadway Licensing Bylaw

#### **PROPOSAL & BACKGROUND**

Administration is seeking Council's direction for Roadway License Bylaw No. 1887 which would authorize the M.D. of Bonnyville to enter into an agreement to license a Roadway in accordance with Policy No. 3A.018 - Licensing of Roadways Policy.

#### **DISCUSSION ON BENEFITS, DISADVANTAGES & OPTIONS**

Bylaw No. 1887 is the amended re-application of expired Roadway Licensing Bylaw No. 1780, as per the legal description in Appendix A.

This Roadway License would be for agricultural purposes, to move livestock from southerly parcels, owned by the applicant, to the northerly portion of NE-24-63-5-W4M. There is an existing fence in the road allowance the applicant would like to remain there for use as an alleyway to move the livestock.

Following the approval of Roadway Licensing Bylaw No. 1780, Administration was made aware of historic and ongoing contention between the applicant and an adjacent landowner with respect to a shared fence within the roadway and unauthorized livestock ingress.

Administration is recommending that Council proceed to first reading of Bylaw No. 1887. If defeated, the Bylaw would not proceed any further, if approved the Bylaw would move forward to public notification and subsequent second reading.
