Title:	Bylaw No. 1874 Corridor Regulation Bylaw

PROPOSAL & BACKGROUND

The Executive Director of North East Muni-Corr Ltd. has requested amendments to the Municipal District of Bonnyville No. 87's Muni-Corr bylaw. These changes would align the M.D. with other Muni-Corr partner communities who have already implemented the changes. It was reviewed by the Committee of the Whole on February 18, 2025, and recommended to Council for approval without changes. It was brought before Council on March 25, 2025, for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd reading at the discretion of Council. During that meeting, the bylaw was unable to proceed to 3rd reading as during 2nd reading it did not receive unanimous consent. Per Section 187(4) of the *Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26*, for a bylaw to receive all three readings in one meeting, unanimous consent by Council is required, and this was not achieved on that day.

It is therefore before Council again for consideration for 3rd reading.

DISCUSSION ON BENEFITS, DISADVANTAGES & OPTIONS

The Director of Protective Services has reviewed the requested amendments and provided feedback to the Executive Director expressing concerns with some of the wording used in the amended bylaw. The Executive Director has accepted these suggestions and agreed to revisit the bylaw within two years as they have a review planned during that time. Despite these gaps, the Executive Director has requested that the amended bylaw be approved by Council to align the M.D. with our other partner communities, as failing to do so could potentially introduce different rules for trail users as they travel between municipal boundaries. Given the imminent review by North East Muni-Corr Ltd, Administration does not object to this amended bylaw being given 3rd reading as stated.
