Title: Bylaw No. 1895 Amending Elections Bylaw

PROPOSAL & BACKGROUND

In December 2024 Council passed Bylaw No. 1881 Elections Bylaw which establishes the rules and procedures for the conduct of municipal elections within the Municipal District of Bonnyville.

Administration is presenting a proposed amendment to Bylaw No. 1881 to allow the Returning Officer to start counting Advance Vote and Special ballots as early as 7:30 p.m. on Election Day.

DISCUSSION ON BENEFITS, DISADVANTAGES & OPTIONS

Section 85.1 of the *Local Authorities Election Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. L-21 authorizes the Returning Officer to designate a single location as a counting centre, if a ward or division system exists in a local jurisdiction, for the purpose of counting the special ballot box, advance vote ballot box and institutional vote, and further allows Council to pass a bylaw, by June 30 of an election year, allowing the Returning Officer to count these ballots no earlier than 7:30 p.m. on election day.

The proposed Bylaw No. 1895 would amend subsections 7.3(c) and 8.12 of the current Elections Bylaw No. 1881 to allow the Returning Officer to order the counting of Advance Vote and Special ballot boxes at 7:30 p.m., instead of the current indicated time of 8:00 p.m.

With the removal of tabulators for the Municipal Election and longer wait times for results due to hand counting of ballots after the closing of a polling station, we are hoping to reduce ballots at polling stations (and subsequently counting time) on Election Day by holding more Advance Vote days and encouraging the use of Special Ballots since the criteria for use has been removed. As such, we are anticipating more votes to count for advance vote days and special ballots. Being able to start counting these ballots at 7:30 p.m. will help reduce wait times for results at the end of Election Day.
