Statement

MUNICIPAL D

All Municipal District of Bonnyville (M.D.) Council members and administrative staff are to wear appropriate present themselves in a professional manner, including attire, at all for each regular Council meetings of Council.

Purpose

The purpose of this policy it to This Policy provides guidance for all members of Ceouncil members and administrative staff regarding suitable attire to maintain a professional environment during Council meetings.

Definitions

For the purposes of this policy:

- (1) "Administrative Staff" means any person employed by the M.D. in a full-time, part-time, or casual capacity;
- (2) "Council" means the duly elected Council of the M.D.;
- (3) "Meeting of Council" means any Regular, Special, or Organizational Meeting of Council;
- (4) "M.D. Issued Clothing" means a piece of clothing or uniform displaying the M.D.'s name or logo.

Policy

- All members of Council members and administrativeon staff in attendance during each regular Council a meeting of Council shall wear attire that is appropriate to the dignity of the Chamber; attire that and maintains portrays a professional appearance.
- (2) Members of Council may wear either business formal or business casual attire, as appropriate for the occasion and should maintain a consistent professional appearance that reflects positively on the M.D. during all Council meetings.
- (3) Public participants of meetings of Council are encouraged to choose clothing that reflects respect for Council and their role in municipal government.
- (4) Participants shall remove or cover up anything determined to be inappropriate or disrespectful when directed by the Chair.
